INTERVENTION IN HUNGARY

If labour is clear about Sues, over Hungary it is not secortain. The continuits press has not reported fully. Popular attention has been directed to Sues. In the Labour novement itself the Deily Worker has played a treacherous role. That of a lickspittle of those who sought to drown the Hungarian workers rising in blood.

On Tuesday, October 23rd, 100,000 Hungarian workers demonstrated. They demanded "A fully independent peace policy". "Full liberty of the press" "Withdrawal of Soviet Occupation Troops" "Long live Inre Negy... he must have his place in the Central Committee" Commented the Daily Worker on the 24th: "No one should think that these events were anti-Hungarian Workers Party or directed against the Hungarian People's Republic".

LIES AND DISTORTIONS

Hext day the shole world turned upside down. Yesterday's same loyal demonstration became a counter revolution. The Communist Party's editorial heavan, "Counter revolution in Hungery steed an uprising on luesday night". The following day it informed its readers "fighting was drawing to a class" adding "the counterrevolutionry efforts were prepared well a head."

On Saturday, 27th, the counter revolution was still about to end. Now it appared that workers councile had been established by the rebels. These "counter revolutionaries" had strangely socialist demnds; workers' management of the factories; 10/15% rise in wages and a ceiling fixed for the highest salaries; sweating by nice mork norms to be ended; nore faulty silowances; apped up in the housing programme; equal status with the Soviet Units ; the fighting westill about to end, on Sunday, John withdrawal of Soviet proops from Hungary by condeming the rising as counter revolutionery and financed by the United States.

GREAT DEMOCRATIC MOVEMENT

On Monday one day later Prime Minister Nagy had acceeded to the rebels' demands. Agreed to abolish the hated security police and asked for negotiation with the Soviet Union on a basis of equality. A cease fire was ordered. Nagy stated explicitly that there was no counter revolution. A great democratic movement had swept "our whole nation in order to secure our independence which is the only basis of a socialist democracy." he said. The Daily Worker resolved its dilemna by simply not printing Gollan's statement of the day before. It admitted the rebels had right that Prime Minister Nagy"called up Soviet troops for help". In its resort of Nagy's speech the previous Friday no such reference had appeared. On the Wednesday Nagy was to state, "We have chased out the Rakosi-Gero gang. That gang tried to smear me by stating that I called for Soviet intervention. That is false. On the contrary it was I who demanded their immediate withdrawal" Nevertheless the Daily Worker continued to repeat that Russian troops had been
